## State Talk From Nancy—July 2011

### Legislative Report

#### A GREAT VICTORY FOR THE PLUMBING INDUSTRY!

Thanks to a combination of industry opposition, lobby strength and plumbing associations partnering together, the Texas State Board of Plumbing Examiners (TSBPE) will remain a strong, independent agency. This is a wonderful example of the legislature listening to the voices of constituents. Their voices were loud and clear and they were heard! The industry sent a strong message to their legislators that they did not want to see the Texas State Board of Plumbing Examiners merged with the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation (TDLR). TDLR is a large licensing umbrella agency overseeing 29+ diverse industries.

Thousands of calls, emails and letters were sent to legislators during the session. Contractors were prepared to testify on the day the bill, HB 3166, would be heard. Two days before the scheduled hearing, the good news was announced - the Texas State Board of Plumbing Examiners was removed from the merger bill. It was a happy day for the plumbing industry in Texas.

Across the country, licensed agencies are being merged into large umbrella agencies in the effort to save money during the current financial budget crunches in most states. In Texas, the merger would not save money for the state. TSBPE has historically operated as both an effective and fiscally efficient agency that is appreciated by the consumer and respected by the industry. Their enforcement and examination programs are among the best in the country. The 24 full time employees oversee 24,000 licensed plumbers and over 24,000 registered apprentices. Among these, 14 staff members are licensed plumbers with years of experience. Bob Maxwell, Executive Director of TSBPE, does an excellent job of directing enforcement and administering the law. He supervises the staff, works with the Board, trains CPE instructors, and remains accessible to the public and the plumbing industry to answer technical questions interpreting plumbing codes adopted by the state regarding the proper installation of plumbing. We appreciate the great job he does for our industry!

PHCC Texas thanks everyone who participated in this strong grassroots lobbying effort. Industry communications with legislators paved the way for the lobby teams and the plumbing associations to do their job. It was a win-win for our industry. TOGETHER WE WIN! THANK YOU!

#### Other bills:

HB 2376 - plumbing license clean-up bill (Before a Master Plumber becomes a Responsible Master Plumber, he will be required to complete a board-approved training program on laws and rules related to the operation of a plumbing business; allows a water supply protection specialist to do customer service inspections through TCEQ and allows them to install, service and repair plumbing associated with use and distribution of rainwater to supply a plumbing fixture, appliance or irrigation system ; allows the plumbing board to deny investigation of a complaint if the person who is the subject of the complaint is engaged in litigation related to the subject of the complaint; allows a licensed plumber to design a multipurpose residential fire protection sprinkler if he holds the fire sprinkler endorsement.)

HB 2643 - HVAC bill - recognizes DOL apprentice programs, allows air conditioning experience in military service to count toward experience; allows other degrees to count toward experience.

HB 2093 - indemnification clauses in construction contracts. Not covered are single family homes, townhouses, duplexes, and oil field work or public work contracts for municipalities. The bill also includes general liability coverage for completed operations (the coverage must be at least 3 years.)

## RULES & GUIDELINES FOR CHILI COOKING TEAMS

- ▶ Traditional chili for this competition is defined as any kind of meat or combination of meats, cooked with chili peppers, spices and other ingredients.
- ▶ CHILI COOKED ON SITE—All chili will be cooked from scratch the day of the cook-off. All chili must be prepared in the open. We encourage propane cooking due to lack of electricity. (no cooking in motor homes, etc.)
- ▶ QUANTITY TO BE COOKED—since chili will be served to the public after judging, you must cook at least 2 gallons of chili.
- ▶ ONE CHILI PER TEAM—each team is responsible for preparing one pot of chili that can be judged and turning in one judging cup from that pot. No more than one judging sample can be taken from any one pot.
- ▶ MANDATORY cook meeting at 12:45 pm

EACH TEAM NEEDS TO SUPPLY THEIR OWN;

Cooking equipment & fuel

Cooking ingredients including meat, spices, etc.

Any condiments you think should be served with your chili.

**Table and chairs for cooking and sitting. You generally will have 18' x 15' cooking & show space.**

Tent if you want one.

Sign(s) to identify your team and team sponsor.

Props. Costume(s) and other gear if you want to enter showmanship as well

# JUDGING CRITERIA

Turn in time for chili is 4:30 pm. No chili will be accepted after that time

Your chili will be blind judged on the following criteria:

**AROMA**—Chili should smell appetizing

**CONSISTENCY**—Chili should be a smooth combination of meat and gravy.

**COLOR**—Chili should look appetizing

**TASTE**—Chili should taste good.

**AFTERTASTE**—Chili should leave a pleasant taste after swallowing.

Each cup of chili will be scored on its own merits with a whole number from 1—10, 10 being the highest.

The PHCC North Texas Chili Committee will provide Paper/Styrofoam bowls, plastic eating utensils, napkins, for chili being served to the public. A Beverage Sponsor will supply water, soft drinks and adult beverage.

**The public will vote on the Best Cook Site People's Choice Award. The winner will be awarded a trophy.**

The Official Chili Judges will award the 1st Place Habanera; 2nd Place Jalapeno and 3rd place Chili Pepper award winners.

**HAVE YOU BEEN THINKING ABOUT BECOMING TSBPE ENDORSED IN MEDICAL GAS INSTALLATION?**

The PHCC Medical Gas Training course is a pre-requisite for testing by TSBPE. Irving is one of two PHCC Medical Gas Training hubs designed for individuals interested in properly installing medical gas systems to NFPA 99 code requirements. Students will learn the requirements for the installation of medical gas & Vacuum systems in health care facilities as well as dental offices. Students are required to successfully perform a vertical and horizontal braze on 1 1/2" copper pipe. Inspector applicants may take this course for 100 hours credit towards their requirements for testing by TSBPE.

Upon completion of the course, the student will schedule his/her medical gas licensing exam with the Texas State Board of Plumbing Examiners. \*\*\*Inspectors, Administrators, Managers, and Supervisors who require knowledge of the requirements and operational theory of Medical Gas Pipeline Systems will greatly benefit from this course as well!\*\*\*
